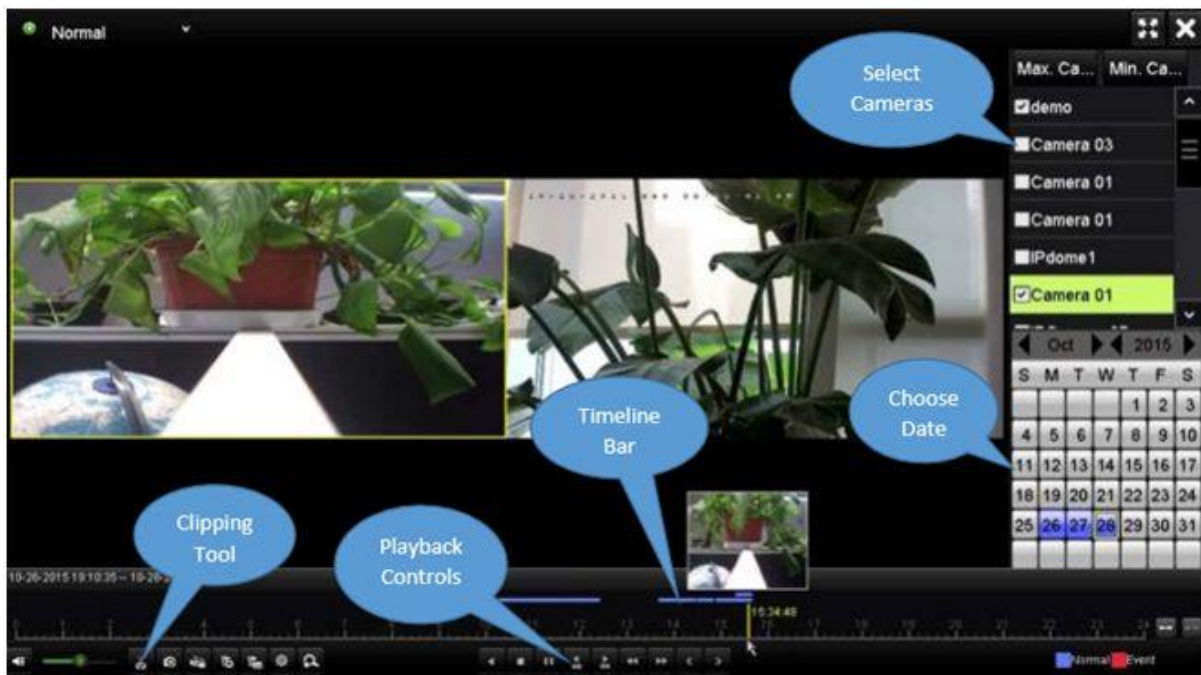
Playing Back & Exporting Footage with a Screen Attached

This guide is specifically for CCTV systems that have a screen directly connected to the recorder box.

All Securico CCTV systems will allow a screen (TV or computer monitor) that use HDMI connectors, or VGA connectors.

Chapter 1. Playback

1. Right-click the mouse anywhere on-screen and click on the “Menu” option.
2. If asked to do so, enter your password.
3. Select “Playback”.
4. Choose the relevant camera(s) by selecting on right hand side of screen.
5. Choose the required date from the calendar box.
6. Press the “Play” Symbol at the bottom of the screen.
7. You can use the play controls to reverse play, fast forward or pause.
8. You can also drag the timeline bar to go to the exact time required.

Chapter 2. Exporting Footage

1. The easiest method to export recorded footage is using the clipping tool.
2. The clipping tool is accessible from the playback screen from previous page.
3. When you are playing back footage, press the clipping tool once, at the beginning of the footage you want to export.
4. Drag the timeline to the end of the footage you want to export and press the clipping tool one more time.
5. Click on the "X" at the top right hand corner of the playback screen and you will be asked if you want to save your clips, click YES.
6. Select your clips by ticking the boxes to the left of them and click export.
7. Choose your destination, USB (USB will only show if you have a USB drive inserted) and click export again.
